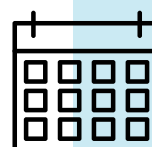
# INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC CONFERENCE

The transition of energy generation and supply from dependence on fossil fuels towards carbon neutrality is a common task of the international community, the European Union and nation states across Europe. It aims to identify best practices in stabilizing and accelerating energy transition processes and to facilitate discourse and learning between legal orders. Focal points are the expansion of renewable energies, but also energy security and participation in transition processes. The conference covers Western and Central European countries and the Baltic region.
